

REGULATION OF THE IX INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN SPORTS GAMES

1. GENERAL TERMS

International children sports games (hereinafter the Games) are organized in purpose to:

- develop the Olympic sports among the children and youth of the Asian part of Russia;
- broaden international cooperation in the realm of sport and physical culture;
 - attract attention to systematic physical activity and sport;
 - organize recreational activities and promotion of healthy life-style;
 - prevent lawbreaking, drug addiction and alcoholism among youth.

2. COMPETITION SCHEDULE

Place: Chita, Zabaikalsky Krai Date: 19-24 August, 2019

Day of arrival: 19 August, 2019 Day of departure: 24 August, 2019

3. EVENT ORAGINIZERS

The Organizing committee is in charge for general management of organization of the Games.

Ministry of Physical Culture and Sports of the Zabaikalsky Krai and approved Major referee's boards are in charge for implementation of the Games

4. REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPANTS AND TERMS OF THEIR ELEGIBILITY

The Games include the following kinds of sport: track and field (athletics), wrestling (freestyle wrestling), boxing, judo, table tennis, volleyball, swimming, archery, mini football, basketball. Combined teams of the Republic of Buryatiya, Mongolia and the People's Republic of China are permitted to participate in the Games. Sportsmen of 2003-2004 years of birth (for table tennis and swimming – 2003-2005 years of birth) are allowed to participate in the Games. All the participating sportsmen must have health insurance and an admission of a doctor.

In particular kinds of sports combined teams of the regions of the Russian Federation are invited to participate in the Games (at the invitation of the Organizing committee).

5. SPORTS AND EVENTS

The programme of the Games includes the following:

Total amount of sportsmen – 171, coaches – 19, referees – 6, doctors – 1.

All the competitions are held according to the approved rules of the international federations of the sports mentioned above.

6. AWARDS

The top 3 rank winner teams in team sports events are awarded with cups and diplomas, members of teams – with medals and diplomas.

The top 3 rank winners in personal sports events are awarded with medals, diplomas and memorable gifts.

Coaches of the winners are awarded with diplomas.

7. FINANCIAL CONDITION

Ministry of Physical Culture and Sports of Zabaikalsky Krai carries out financial provision of health and sports events in accordance with the Order of financing and Terms of expenses on holding health and sports events included in the Calendar plan of health and sports events of Zabaikalsky Krai.

Participating parties are responsible for round-trip transportation expenses (transport tickets, daily allowances during trip, insurance)

Registration fee is 50 USD per day for each participant of the Games (sportsmen, coaches, doctors). The fee includes accommodation and meals for each participant.

The Organizing committee takes expenses for accommodation and meals for 5 officials and 6 referees from the delegations of Mongolia and the People's Republic of China during the IX International Children Sports Games.

Expenses for insurance of the members of the delegation are taken by the local budget of the Russian Federation and extrabudgetary funds according to the present legislation of the Russian Federation.

8. ENSURING THE SAFETY OF PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS

Sports activities are held at sports facilities that meet the requirements of the relevant regulatory legal acts in force in the territory of the Russian Federation and aimed at ensuring public order and safety of participants and spectators, provided there are acts of readiness of sports facilities to conduct sports activities approved in the established order.

9. INSURANCE OF PARTICIPANTS

Participating in the Games is allowed only in case of having health insurance policy (original) from accidents. The certificates are sent to the Commission for admission of participants.

10. APPLICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Preliminary applications for participation in the Games in the prescribed form (Appendix 1) are submitted to the Ministry of Physical Culture and Sports of Zabaikalsky Krai before June 10, 2019 by e-mail: **sportotdelzk@yandex.ru**, with indication of sports and the total number of participants and representatives.

Teams arriving at the competition must submit the following documents to the Commission for admission of participants:

- a nominal application in the prescribed form (Appendix 2), certified by the head of the executive body of a region of the Russian Federation in the field of physical culture and sports and a doctor about admission of each participant to the competitions (for regions of the Russian Federation) or an application in the prescribed form (Appendix 2), certified by the executive body in the field of physical culture and sports and a medical certificate of admission to the competition (for foreign athletes);
 - certificate of birth or passport of each participant;
 - insurance policy (original) of each participant.
